The Parables of Jesus

Learn what it means to be a citizen of God's Kingdom by reading each parable every day of a week. Use these different Bible study methods as you read. Record your discoveries.

Day 1. **Scan It** Read the passage two times. What are your first impressions?

Day 2. **Speak It** Read the Passage out loud 2 or 3 times emphasizing different words.

Day 3. **See It** As you read, imagine yourself in the scene. How would you feel? Read a few times from the perspectives of different characters.

Day 4. **Search It** Ask detective questions: who, what, where, why, when, how. Is there

- A Promise to claim?
- A Sin to confess?
- An Example to follow?
- An Attitude to change
- A Command to obey?
- An Error to avoid?
- A Truth to believe

Day 5. **Say It** in Your Own Words – paraphrase the passage.

Day 6. **Summarize It** – Write a timeless principle from the passage that applies to our world.

Day 7. **Share It** – tell one person what you will do because of this passage.
