Goal for Week Six: To begin to discover my unique God-created part in His Mission

Read Ephesians 2:10 – For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

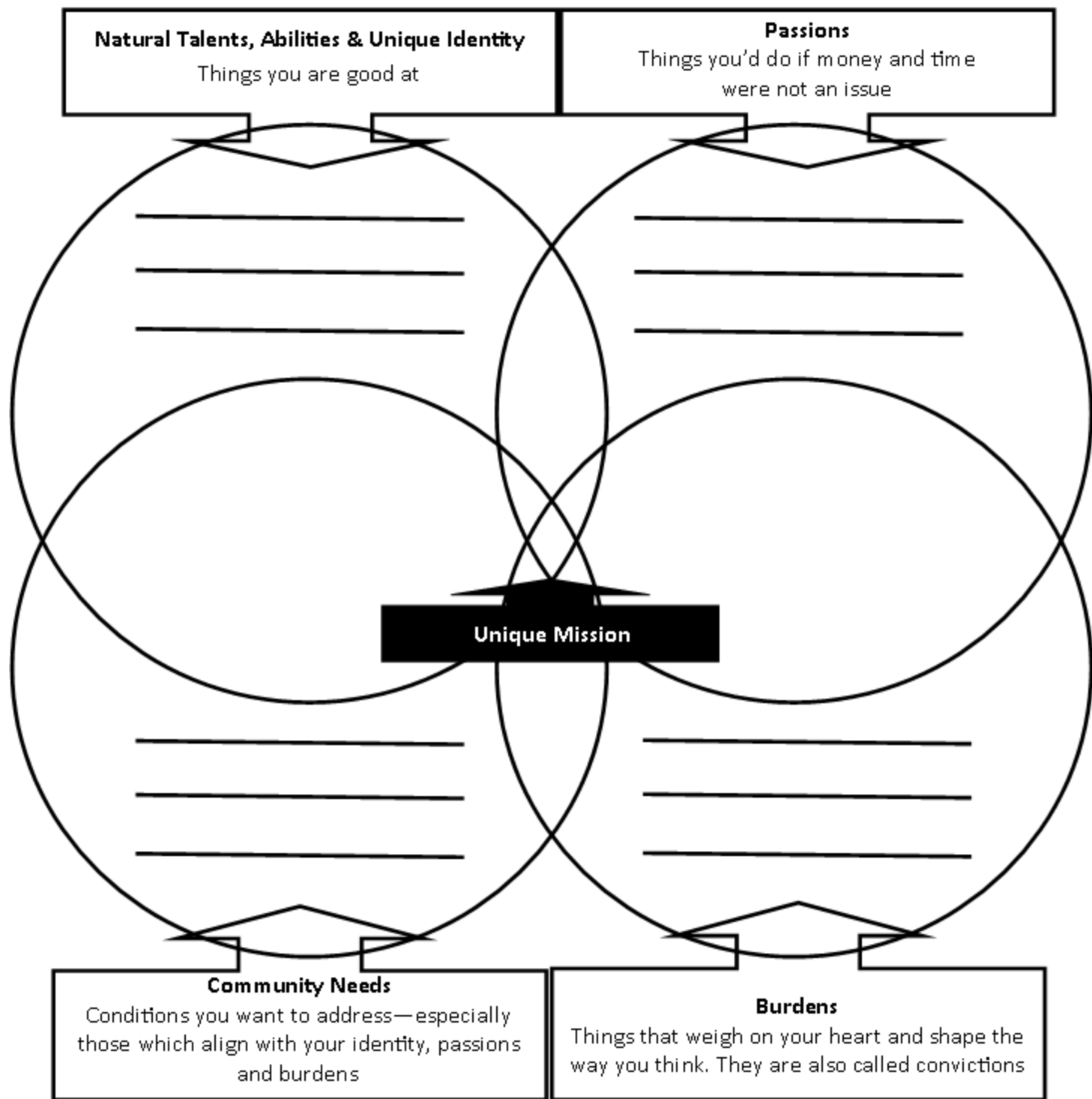
If God prepared good works in advance for you to do, does this change how you view your purpose and mission?
